



Call for Anaesthetic & Intensive Care Assessors

MBRRACE-UK Confidential Enquiries into Maternal Deaths

MBRRACE-UK, in collaboration with The RCoA/OAA, is seeking to appoint new anaesthetic and intensive care assessors to support the Confidential Enquiries into Maternal Deaths. We aim to recruit individuals who are geographically representative across the four UK nations and regionally representative within England.

Role Overview

- Case Reviews: Assessors will be expected to review approximately 10–15 cases per year, depending on the annual report topics.
- Term: Initial appointment is for three years, with the option to renew for a further three years.
- Remote Working: Most work will be conducted electronically, so no travel is required.
- Remuneration: This is an unpaid role, but participation may count towards continuing professional development (CPD).

Selection Criteria

Essential:

- In good standing with the RCoA/OAA
- Recent active clinical practice

Desirable:

- Demonstrated interest or contribution to patient safety, quality improvement, national audit, or research
- Experience in confidential case review
- Previous involvement in committee work at a national level
- Evidence of collaboration within and beyond one's own professional group
- Relevant specialist experience in obstetrics
