- Deleting forms

### **Change of Consent**

- Scenario 1:
  - Baby is halting pathway but otherwise data collection/involvement remains unchanged.
  - Only a Discontinuation Form is completed.
- Scenario 2:
  - Baby is halting pathway and parents want to stop doing part or all of the data collection.
  - Both a Discontinuation Form and a Withdrawal Form are completed.
- Scenario 3:
  - Parents halt some or all data collection but baby's pathway is continuing (e.g. this pathway is your standard care practice).
    - Only a Withdrawal Form is completed.
