

**Currently, UKOSS is collecting information on cases of:**

## **Amniotic Fluid Embolism**

**EITHER** a clinical diagnosis of AFE (acute hypotension or cardiac arrest, acute hypoxia or coagulopathy in the absence of any other potential explanation for the symptoms and signs observed)

**OR** a pathological diagnosis (presence of fetal squames or hair in the lungs).

## **HLH (Haemophagocytic Lymphohistiocytosis)**

Any pregnant or recently pregnant (<6 weeks since delivery) woman with a diagnosis or suspected diagnosis of haemophagocytic lymphohistiocytosis (HLH) or macrophage activation syndrome (MAS).

## **Peripartum Hysterectomy**

Any woman undergoing surgical removal of the uterus during pregnancy or within 42 days of the end of pregnancy.

## **Severe respiratory virus infection in pregnancy and participating in the RECOVERY or REMAP-CAP Trial**

Any woman admitted to hospital in pregnancy and participating in the RECOVERY or REMAP-CAP Trial.
