

Currently, UKOSS is collecting information on cases of:

Amniotic Fluid Embolism

EITHER a clinical diagnosis of AFE (acute hypotension or cardiac arrest, acute hypoxia or coagulopathy in the absence of any other potential explanation for the symptoms and signs observed)

OR a pathological diagnosis (presence of fetal squames or hair in the lungs).

HLH (Haemophagocytic Lymphohistiocytosis)

Any pregnant or recently pregnant (<6 weeks since delivery) woman with a diagnosis or suspected diagnosis of haemophagocytic lymphohistiocytosis (HLH) or macrophage activation syndrome (MAS).

Peripartum Hysterectomy

Any woman undergoing surgical removal of the uterus during pregnancy or within 42 days of the end of pregnancy.

Primary Ciliary Dyskinesia (PCD)

All pregnant women with a diagnosis of primary ciliary dyskinesia (PCD) either prior to or during the current pregnancy who are booked for antenatal care in a UK obstetric unit.

Severe respiratory virus infection in pregnancy and participating in the RECOVERY or REMAP-CAP Trial

Any woman admitted to hospital in pregnancy and participating in the RECOVERY or REMAP-CAP Trial.
